









## 2019-20 Per Member Revenue Limit Waukesha County K-12 School Districts




#### 2019-20 Mill Rate Waukesha County K-12 School Districts




#### Mukwonago Area School District Historic Mill Rate





- 19,000-square-foot industrial building that could potentially expand to more than 23,800 square feet

■ Touchpad Electronics to build a 22,500-square-foot industrial building that could expand up to 48,000 square feet at a 3.8-acre site

The approved development is located on 50 acres by the YMCA and Pro-Health Care near Wolf Run on the village's south side. Plans for the development show 100,000 square feet of retail and commercial space and approximately 657 standard and senior living apartments.
