To whom it concern,

The annual run summary for 2010 is as follows: total fire calls were 321 and total EMS calls were 1694 for a total call volume for 2010 of 2015 calls. Total fire loss for 2010 was \$47,200.00. The MFD was busy responding to several different types of calls for emergency and service calls. MFD responded to 51 different types of fires, 79 motor vehicle collisions and 53 false alarms. On the EMS calls MFD had 893 ALS transports and 239 BLS transports.
